- Classroom: Flexible schedule, work at your own pace, individualized instruction.

- Math-Fast track packets specific to math sub test of TASC exam.

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HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY (HSE) PATHWAYS

- National External Diploma Program: flexible, self-directed online competency based program that leads to a HSE diploma.
- Regents Credit: Count passed regents exams towards subtests of the TASC Exam.
- TASC Exam Exemption: Has passed at least 3 sections on GED, TASC, or Regents Exam, is enrolled in preparation program, and displays readiness to pass one or two remaining sections.
- TASC Exam: Take all sections of exam (reading, writing, social studies, science, and math) and pass with a minimum score of 500 on each subtest.
