

MASTER'S DEGREE STIPEND

Teachers may be required to earn a Master's Degree for their permanent or professional certificate. When a teacher has earned his or her Master's Degree, an <u>official transcript and this form</u> must be sent to Human Resources in order for stipend payment to be processed. Payment <u>will not</u> be processed without an official transcript.

Payment for a Master's degree will be prorated during the first year of payment, and the payment will be added to base salary at the beginning of the next school year. Payment for a Master's degree will be made on October 1 and March 1 of each year, upon the submission of an official transcript and this form.
